## WTA Chainsaw Instructors Code of Ethics October 3, 2009.

This code of Ethics lists the Principles of the WTA Chainsaw course. Each Instructor must follow it. Any action in contravention to this Code of Ethics will result in a review by the Disciplinary Committee. Depending on the severity of the offence this may result in suspension or dismissal. There are two copies of this document you must sign and date both of them and keep one and send the other to the WTA.

### Responsibilities and Principles:

1. To respect all students and generate a learning environment.
2. To provide a current insurance certificate annually of not less than \$3million.
3. To follow course standards (Course duration and class size).
4. To continually improve my skills and knowledge.
5. Report any incidents / problems. Be environmentally responsible.
6. Complete all registration documentation accurately. Send in for immediate registration.
7. Attend meetings and personal development seminars hosted by WTA. Maintain 10 points per annum.
8. To promote the goals of the WTA.
9. To respect all other Instructors and act in a professional manner.
10. To always promote safety and lead by example. To follow all local regulations.
11. Must provide proof of current Standard First Aid Training.
12. Must meet equipment requirements for every course.
13. There must be clear written separation of WTA sanctioned courses and other courses provided to clients.
